Application for Seniors from Chippewa Falls Area Schools

Knights of Columbus will award three \$1000 scholarships to seniors from McDonell Central High School, Chippewa Falls High School, or home-schooled students living within the Chippewa Falls Unified School District area who plan to continue their education at a college, university, or technical school.

Applicants need not be members of the Knights of Columbus or Catholic Church. Note: We have a separate program for those who will be attending a seminary.

About Us

The Goldsmith Council was founded on June 13, 1905. It is named after Father Charles F.X. Fill out the Personal Information page. Please print or download a fillable form at www.kofc974.com/scholarships (illegible forms will be rejected)

Use a separate sheet of paper for each of the following requirements. Do not include any identifying information in your answers. Place the requirement number and page number in the upper right corner of each page (example: 2-2 for requirement 2, page 2). Each answer should be double spaced in at least 12 point font.

1. Briefly describe your plans for post-secondary education, including the school(s) you plan to attend, whether or not you have been accepted, and your intended course of study.

2. Provide a list of all activities and community service projects you have been involved in at your school, church, and community. Include the duration of your involvement (by date or grade, as applicable) and the approximate time commitment total or per month (or other time period if applicable) for each activity. For each activity, briefly describe what you did and any offices held or awards received.

Example:

Hospital Volunteer (grades 11 and 12, 16 hours per month)
Greeted patients and visitors and provided directions
Taught CCD/Sunday school (grade 12, 36 hours total)
Taught 3rd graders
French Club (grades 10-12, 6 hours per month)
President in 12th grade

3. Knights of Columbus are dedicated to Charity. Our Catholic faith teaches us to "Love thy neighbor as thyself". This begins with helping those around us who are most in need, both materially and spiritually, and extends into a commitment to personal involvement in our community to better the quality of life for all of our fellow citizens.

Write an essay describing the importance of Charity in your life, focused on the command to "Love thy neighbor as thyself". Describe times you have been charitable and times you have received charity and how this has shaped your future plans and goals.

Essay should be no more than three typed pages double spaced.

4. Include one letter of recommendation from someone directly associated with one of the activities or service projects listed in number 2 of the application. Only one recommendation letter per scholarship application. Letters of recommendation do not need to omit personally identifying information; they will be redacted as necessary prior to review.
