HISTORY

Council and community activities: A New Year's Eve Party is held annually. The Annual Wives Night is usually held on Valentine's Day. It honors the wives of the members and deceased members.

Annual Awards Night is a banquet which honors the priest and nuns of Chippewa Falls.

Our council participates in the annual Drive to Aid the Mentally Retarded. Community masses are held, one in each of the three churches.
