### New Ceremonial Degrees for the Knights of Columbus

The Knights of Columbus Supreme Council has changed the ceremonial for the First, Second and Third Degrees. The First and Second Degree used to take about an hour each to complete. The Third Degree took about ninety minutes to two hours to complete. In this busy world, it was hard for men to give up that much time to attend each of those degrees. We also had many situations where a man would take the first degree and then not come back for the second and third degrees. Beginning this year the First, Second and Third Degrees are combined into one degree ceremony that takes about 45 minutes to complete. The new ceremony can be exemplified by using a video. If the council chooses to do it live, there are only a few men needed to present the lessons on Charity, Unity, and Fraternity. The ceremonial robes are no longer used. The presenters are dressed in a suit and tie along with a Ceremonial Baldric across the chest (much like the Baldrics the 4th degree uses). Our Council has used the video ceremony to bring in new members this past year. The video presentation does a good job of presenting the lessons in a language that is more in line with modern times. Please try to attend one of these ceremonies in the near future. We are sure you will also be impressed with the presentation. The Fourth Degree is also being done with a virtual presentation. One has been scheduled for October 24, 2020.
