Brother Knight Cyril Krista who heads up the Bingo program says that he is in dire need of more workers. Brother Knights - Bingo is the largest program of Fr. Goldsmith Council 974. The proceeds from Bingo fund the majority of our Charity Donations and also provide funds to help maintain the KC hall. Last year over \$57,000.00 was donated to Charity and given to our Parishes and MACS. If we did not have the Bingo funds available we would be in tough shape and not be able to make many charitable donations to our parishes and schools let alone maintain our facility. Hall Rentals (that pay) do not bring in enough money to completely maintain the hall. Most of the men who work Bingo are there nearly every Friday night. They are burning out. They need more volunteers so they could rotate the days they need to work. Brother Cyril challenges his brother knights, who are not helping to volunteer at least one Friday a month to help with Bingo. If he had more volunteers the workers could be scheduled on a rotating basis and would not have to be there every Friday evening. Please consider volunteering to help. 
